# POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Post-operative instructions must be followed carefully to ensure quick recovery. Some swelling, stiffness, and discomfort are to be expected after a surgery.

## Day of operation

#### **BLEEDING**

- Keep gauze pack in mouth until bleeding has stopped, applying constant, firm pressure, and replace it every half hour if needed.
- 2. If bleeding persists, bite on a gauze pad or moist tea bag. Repeat if necessary.
- 3. Keep head elevated and rest quietly.
- Apply ice bag to affected area at 30 min. intervals for 24-48 hours after surgery during waking hours.
- 5. Some oozing of blood and discoloration of saliva are to be expected.

#### **AVOID**

Until bleeding is controlled, avoid eating (up to a maximum of 5 hours). During the first 24 hours, avoid sucking on the wound, spitting, using mouthwash, smoking, exercising, or drinking with a straw. Avoid sports or strenuous physical activities for 24-48 hours after surgery.

#### **PAIN**

Take prescribed medication for pain as directed. If the prescribed medication does not adequately eliminate pain, please call our emergency number.

#### DIET

Liquid or soft food only, at room temperature. (Avoid hot foods.) You can start to eat as soon as 2 to 4 hours after surgery as long as bleeding is controlled.

### **MEDICATION**

If antibiotics are prescribed, they SHOULD be taken until treatment is complete.

### From second day to complete healing

- Rinse mouth with salt water (add 1/4 teaspoon of salt to 200 ml / 8 oz of boiled water). Repeat rinsing after meals, every day until next appointment.
- 2. Your diet may consist of soft to regular food as desired.
- 3. Continue with medication for pain if needed, and rest.
- 4. Two days after surgery, apply hot compresses on cheeks if required.
- Continue to take antibiotics as prescribed by your doctor until the end of the treatment.
